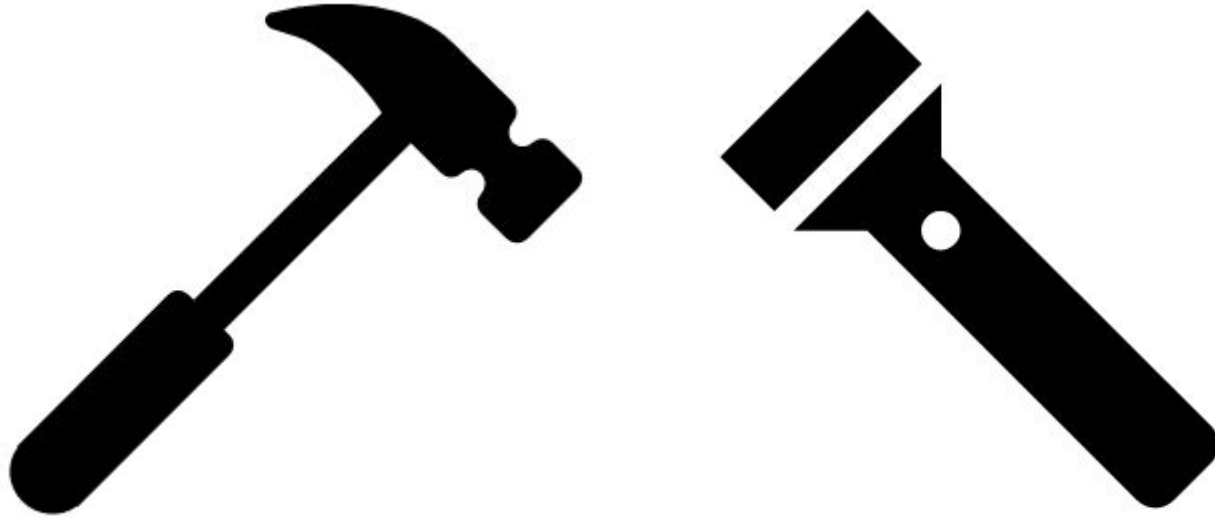

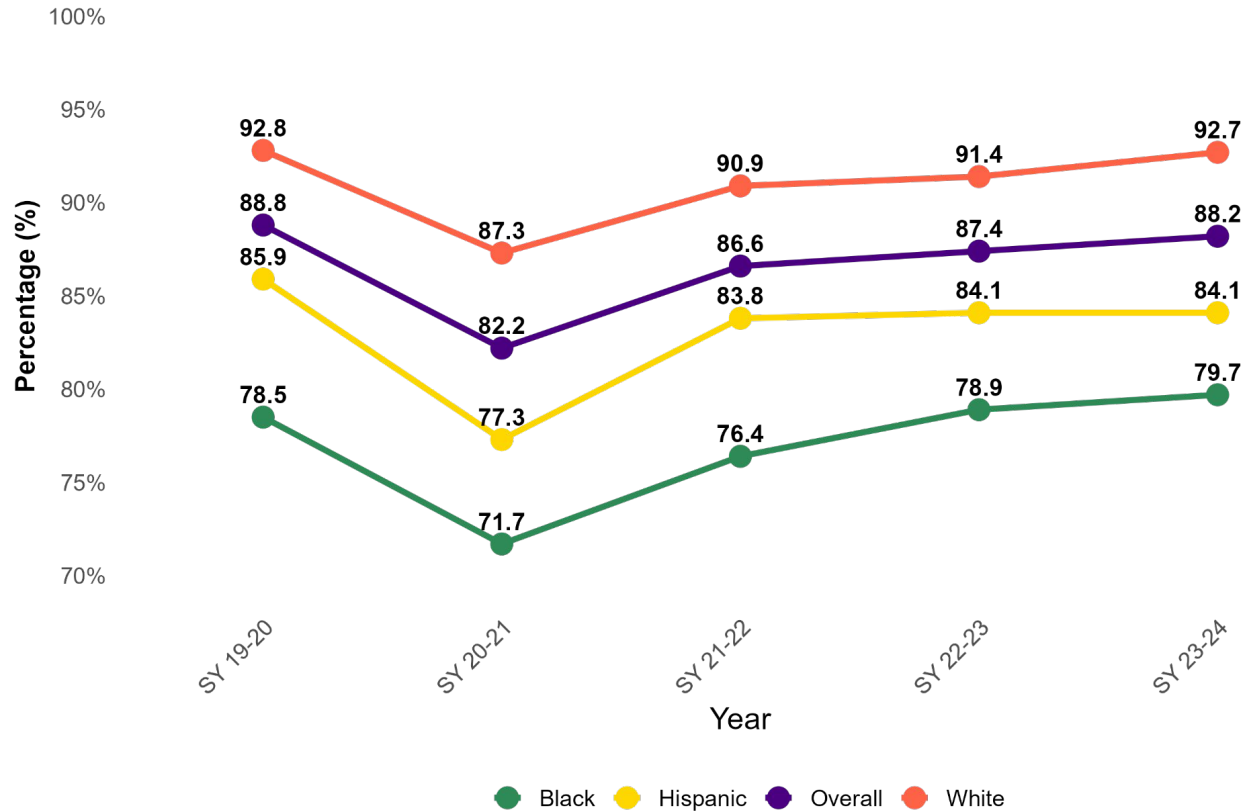

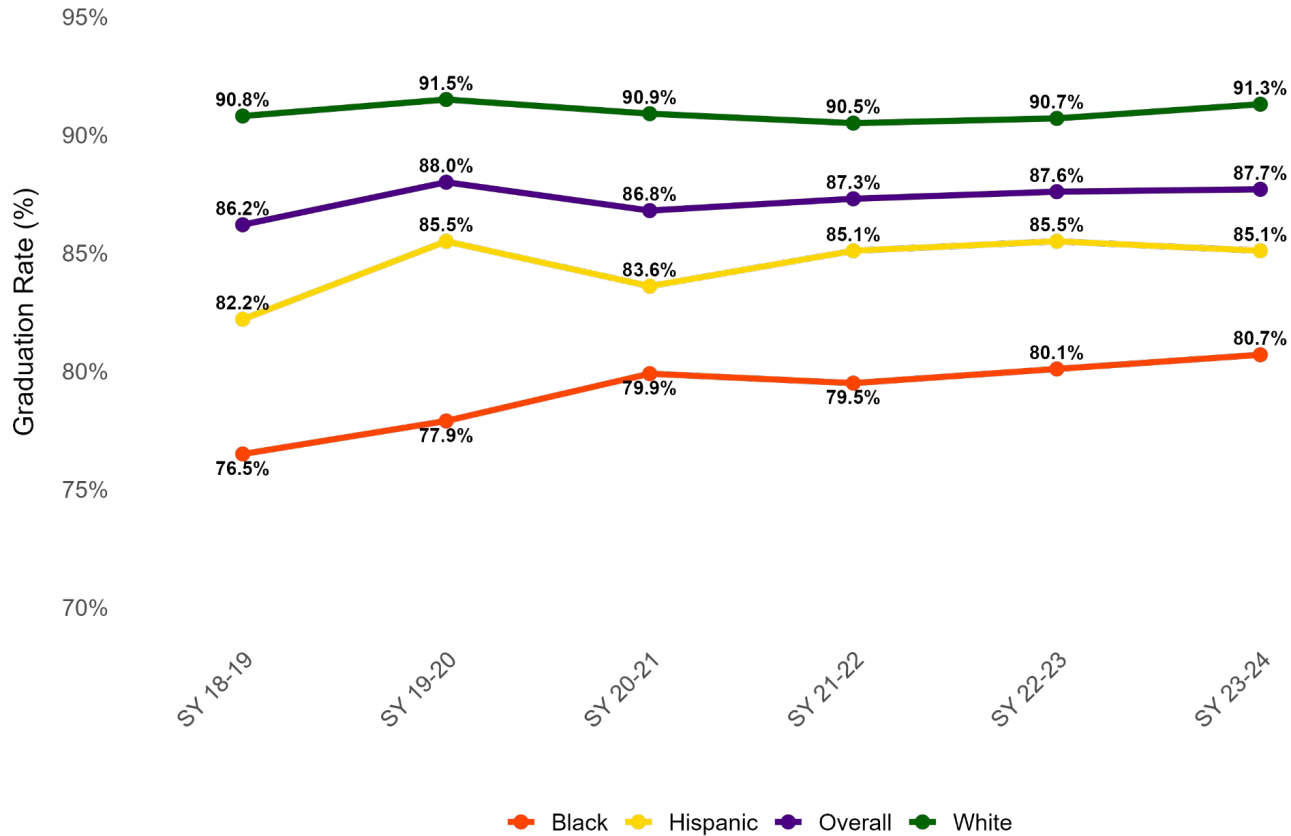
9th Grade on Track

Comparison by Race

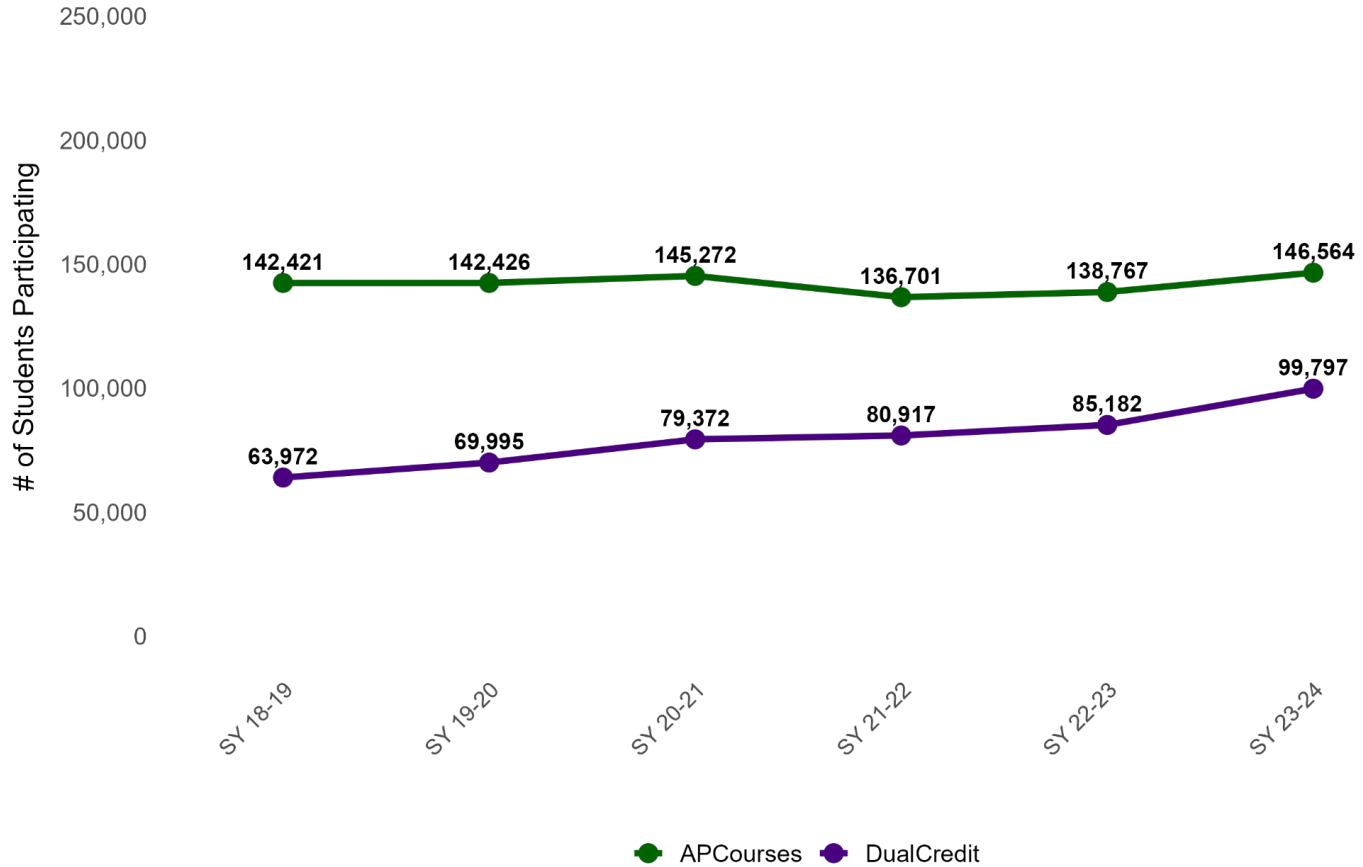

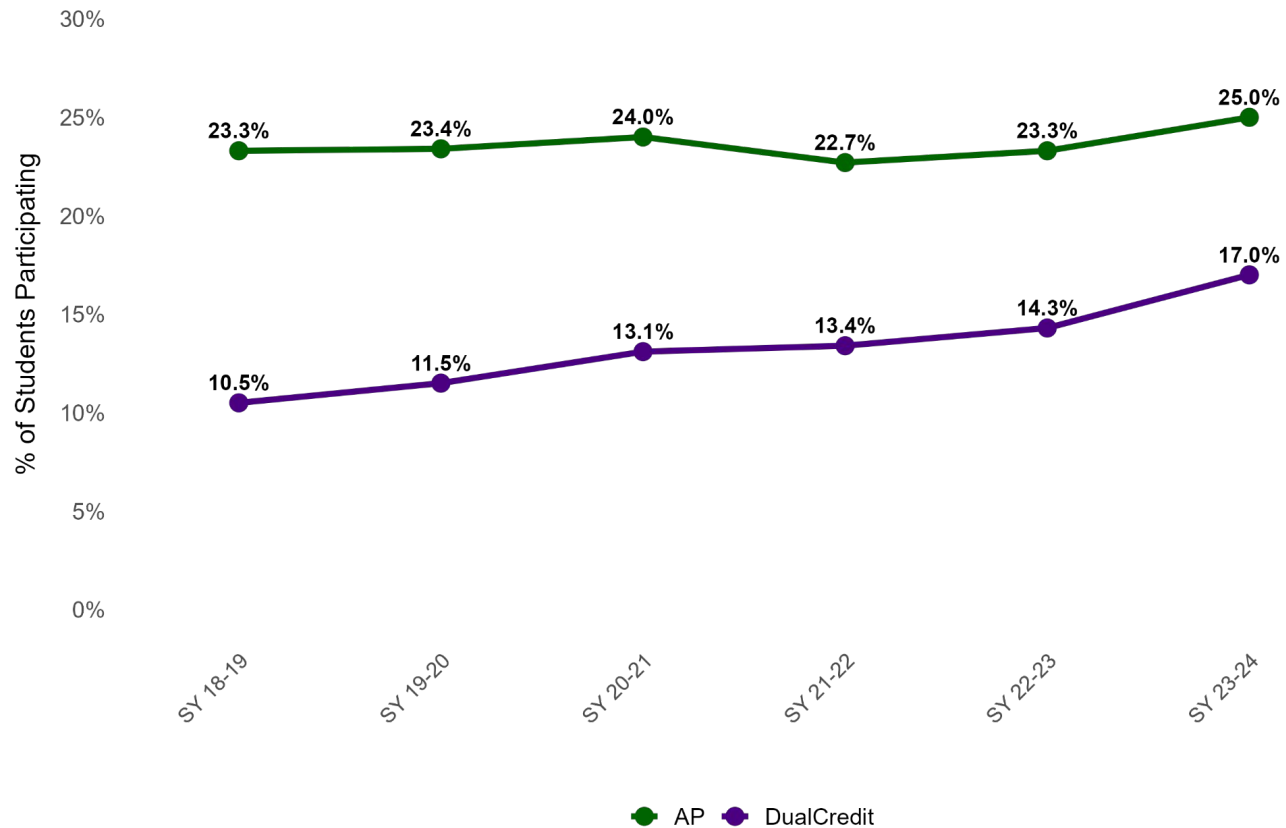
Early College Coursework Participation Trends

Dual Credit and AP Course Participation



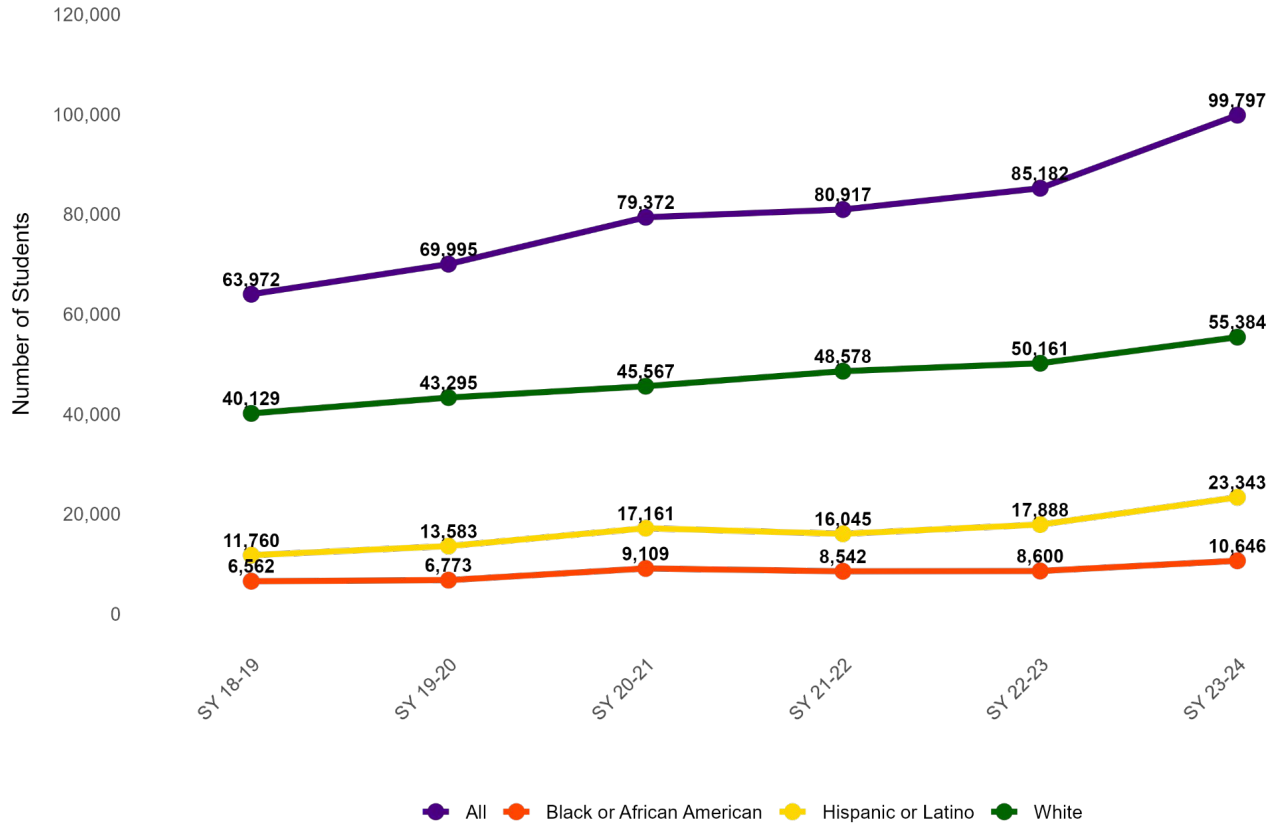

AP and Dual Credit Participation



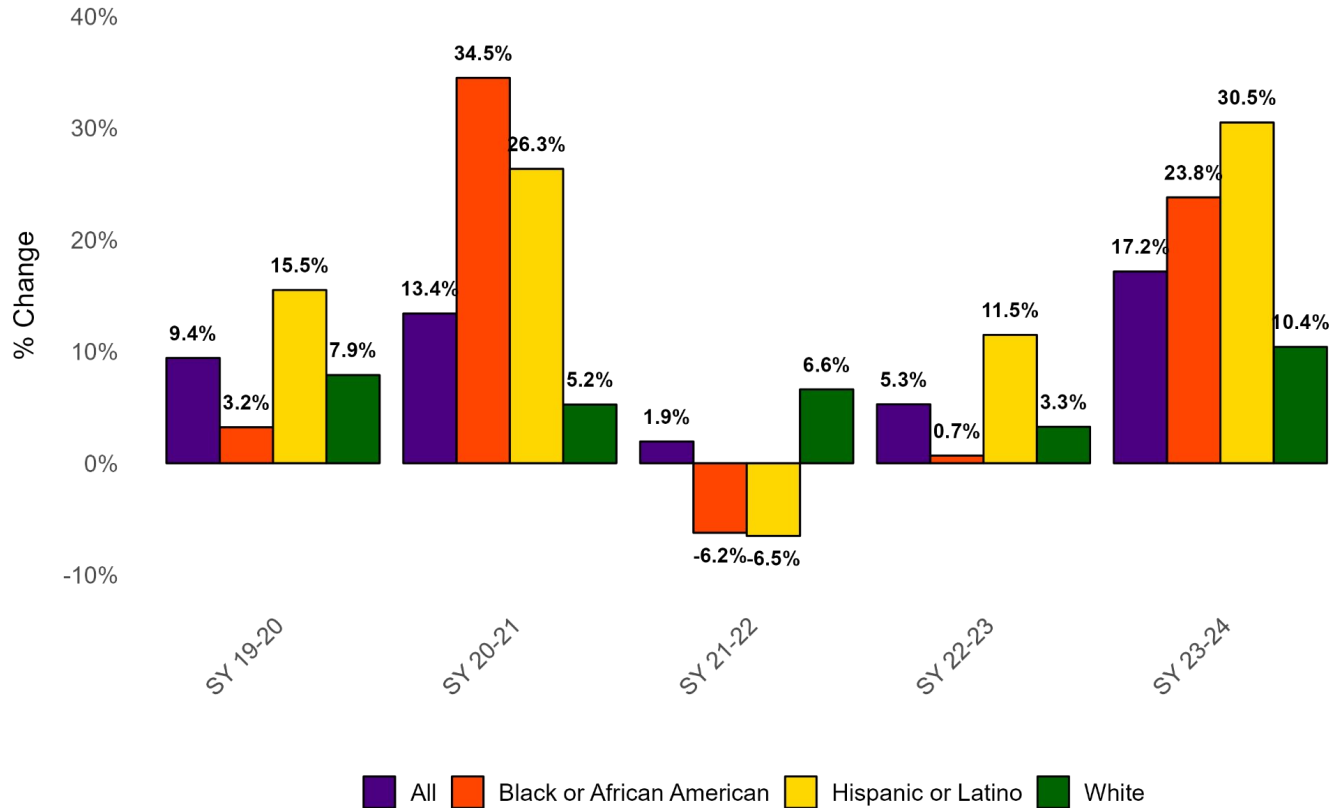

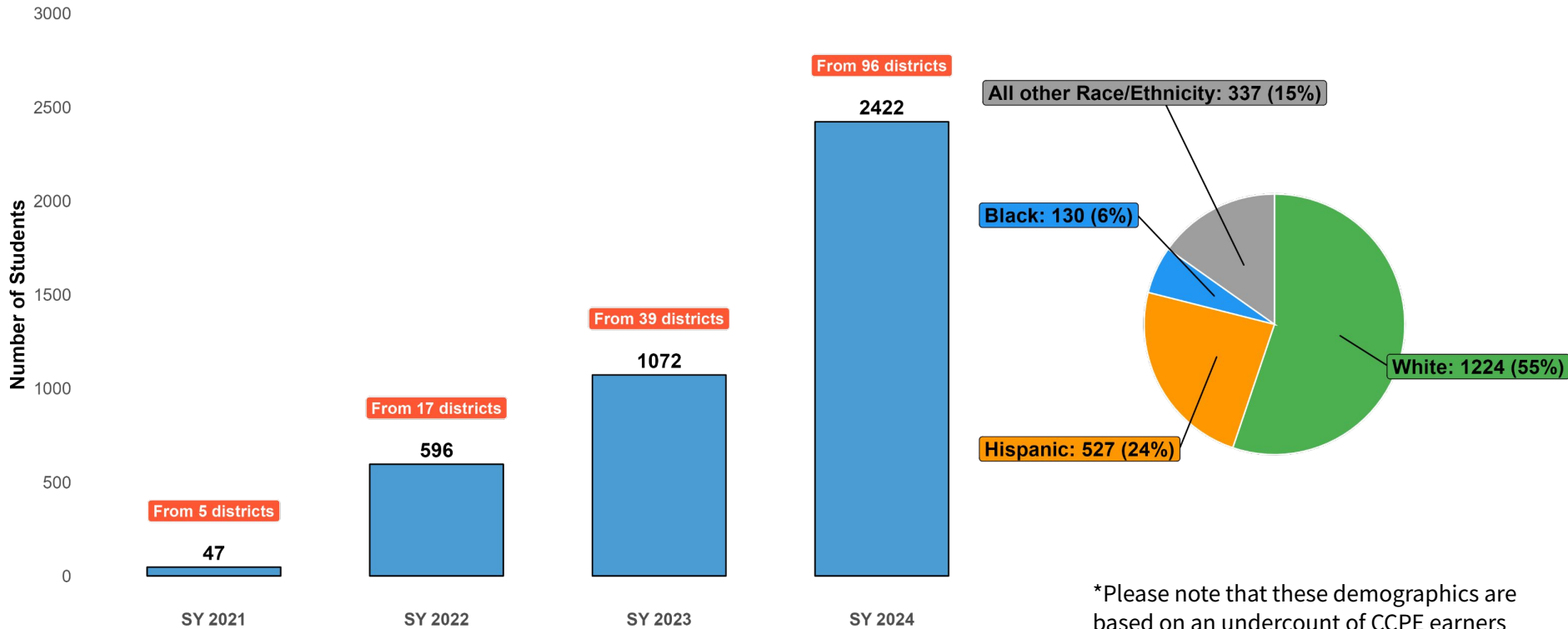

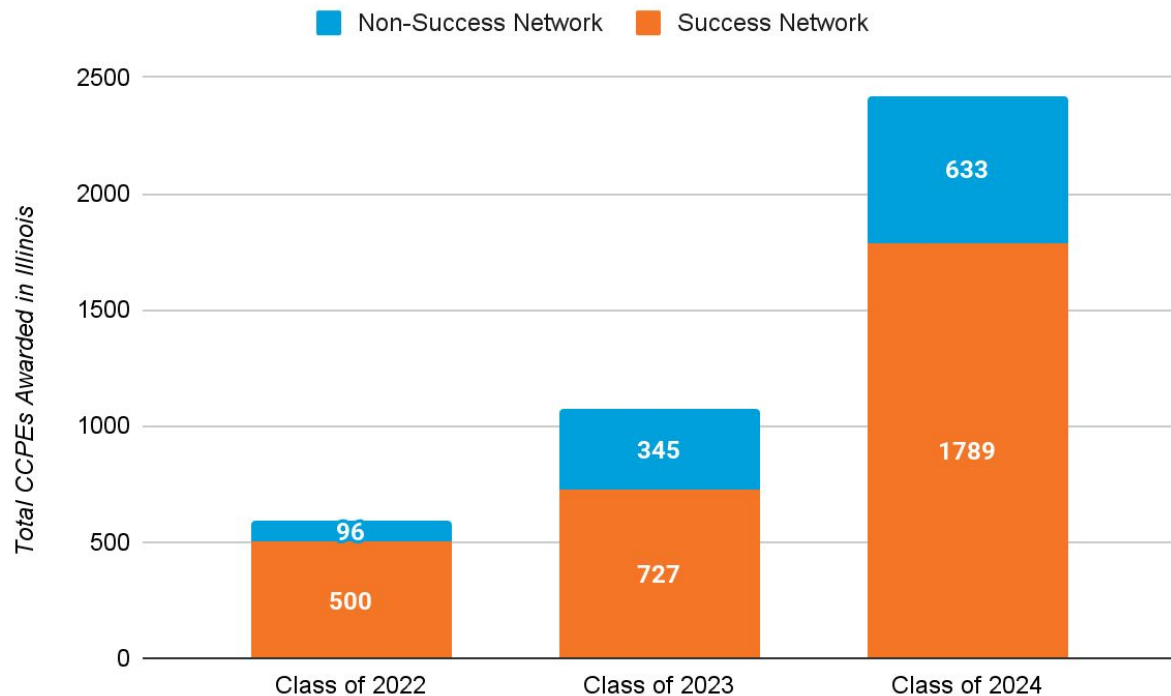
Total Number of College and Career Pathway Endorsements

College and Career Pathway Endorsement (CCPE) Earners

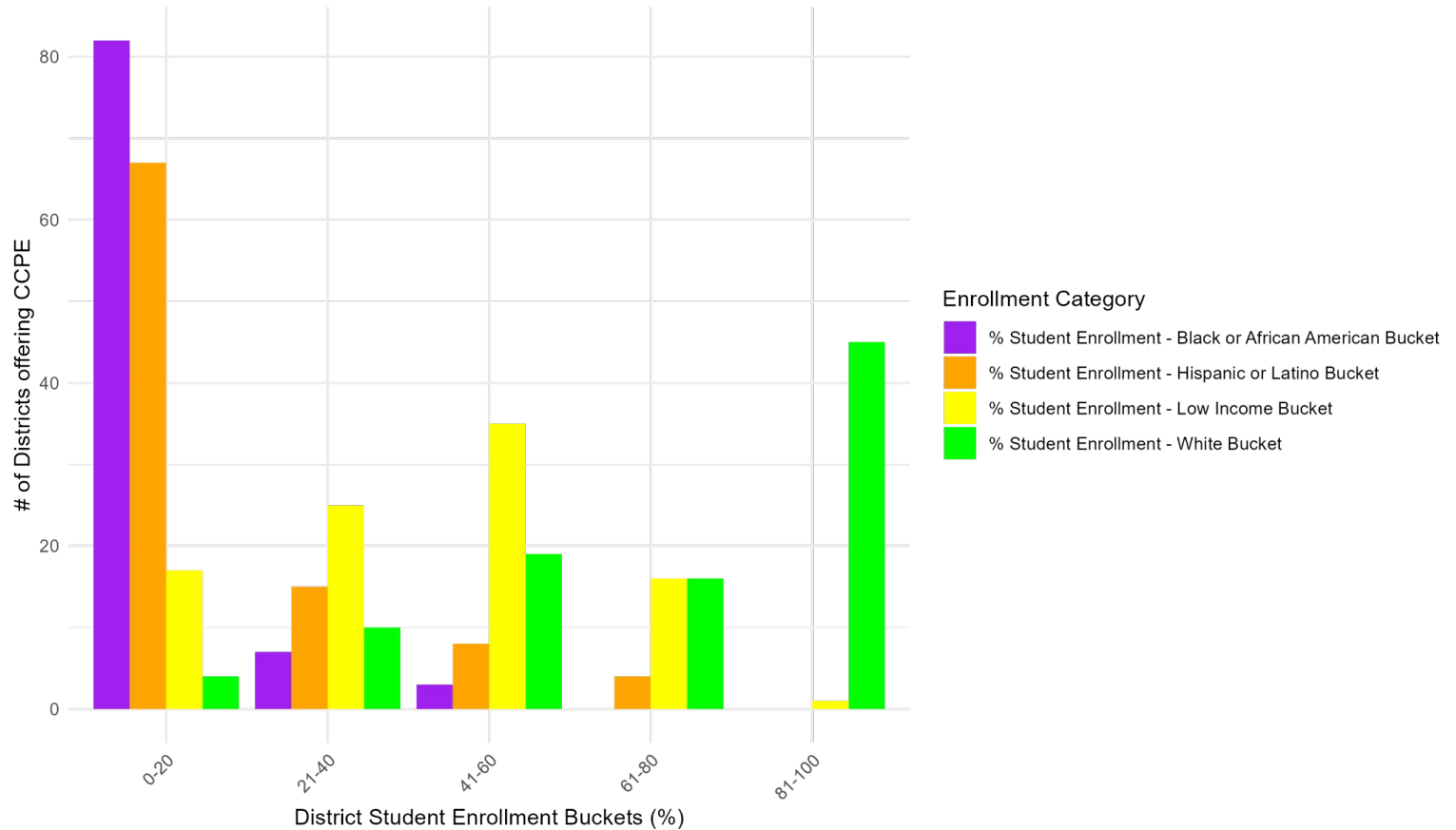

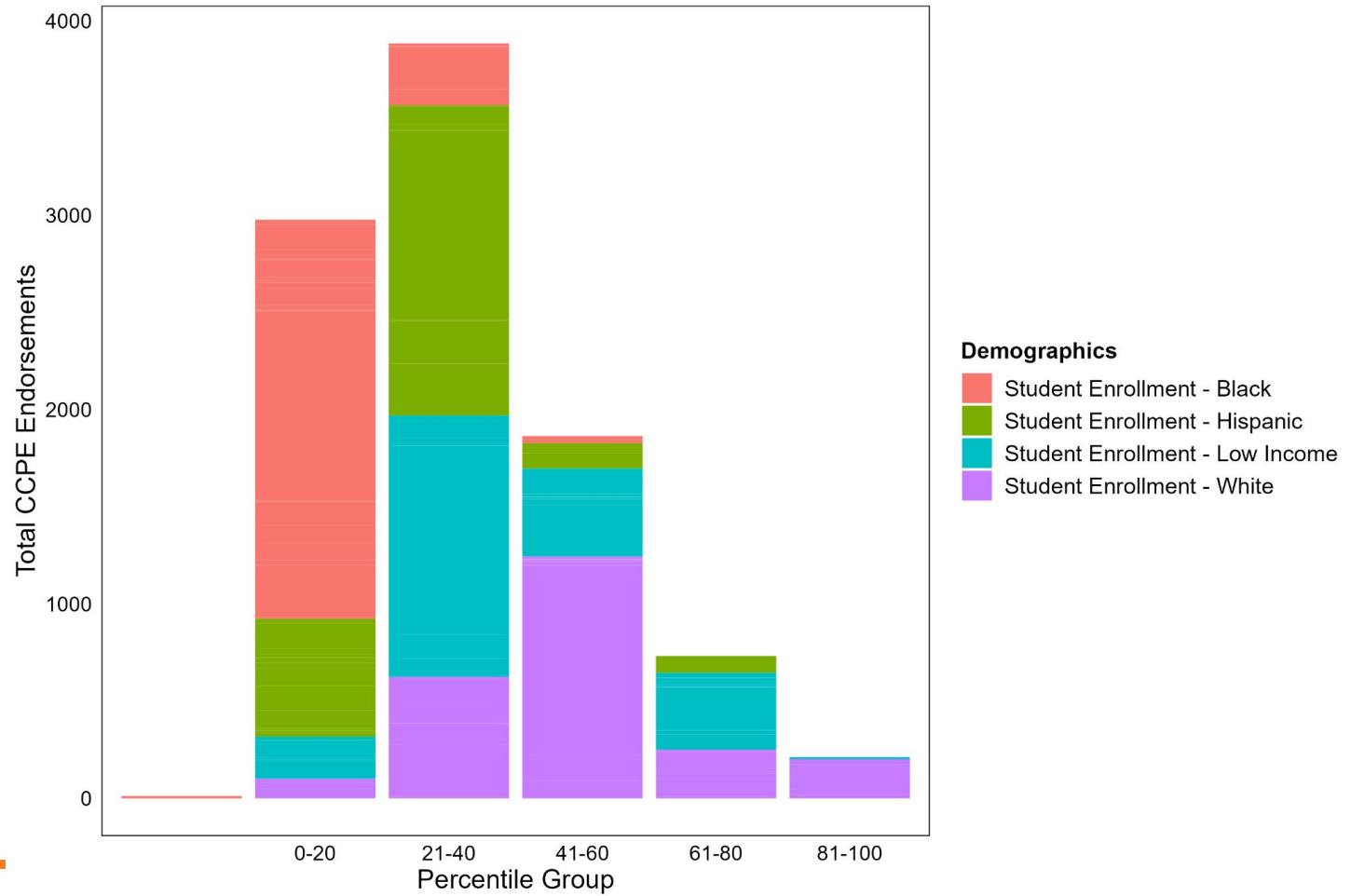

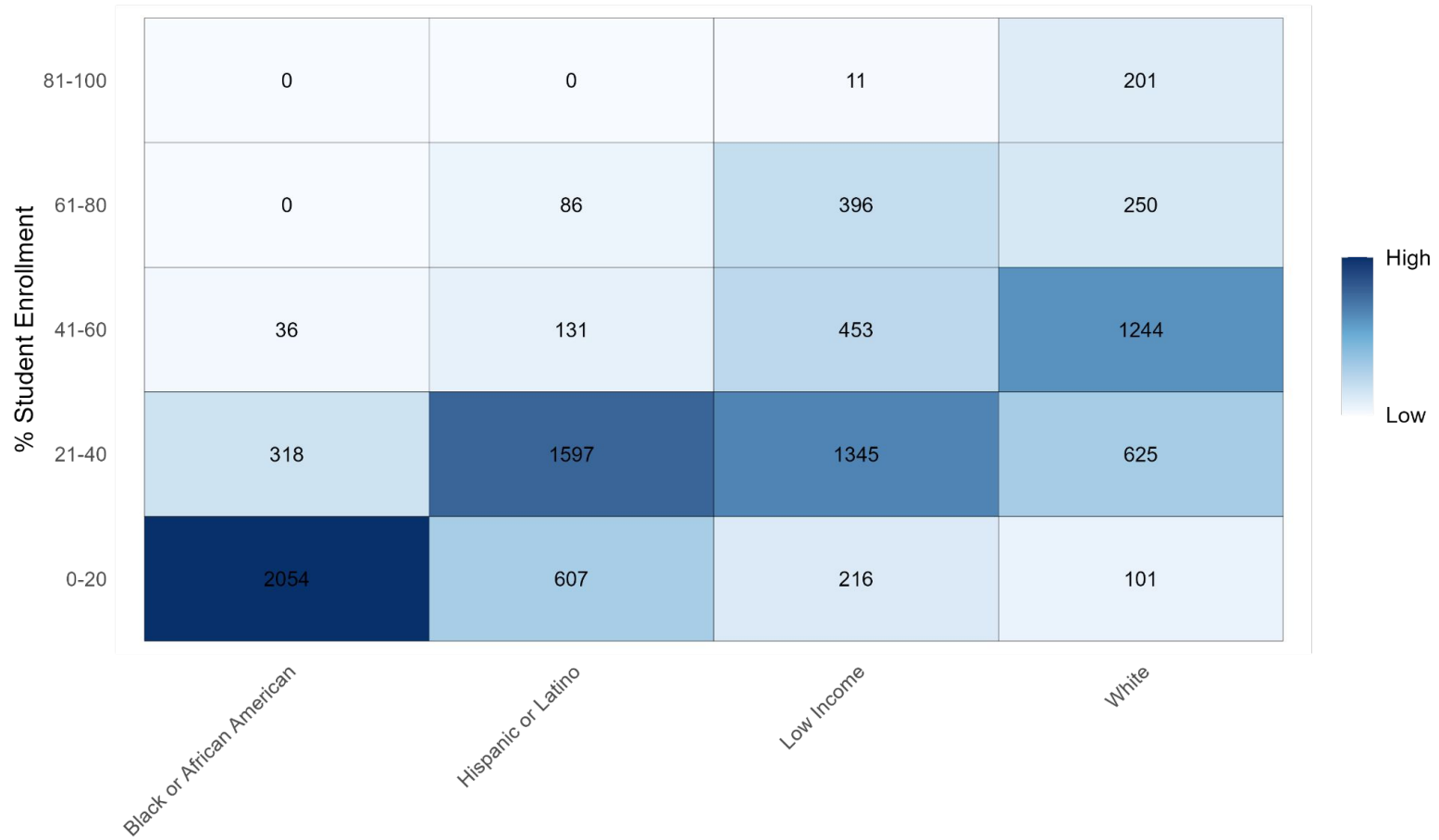

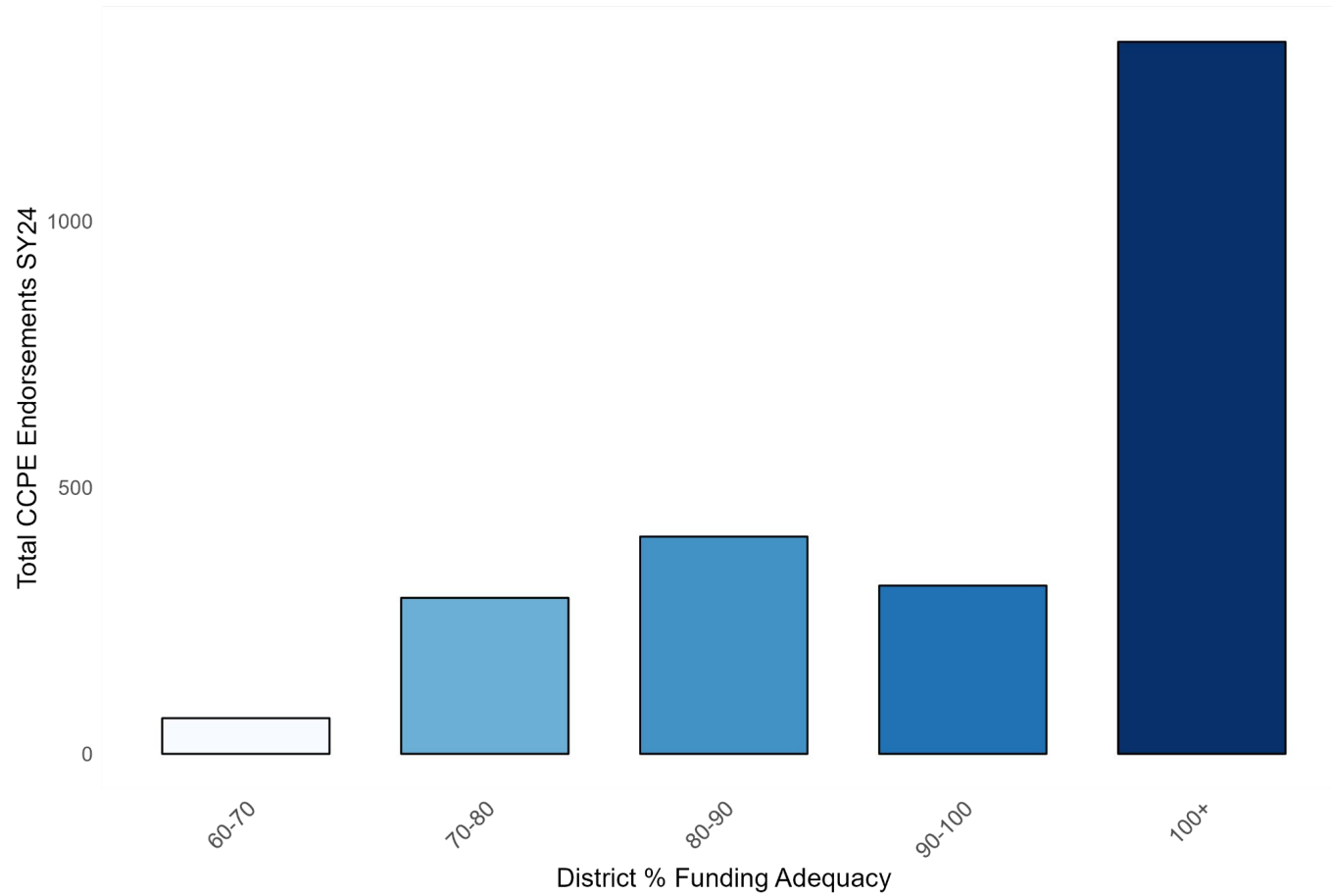
Total CCPE Endorsements by District Demographic Breakdown, SY 23-24

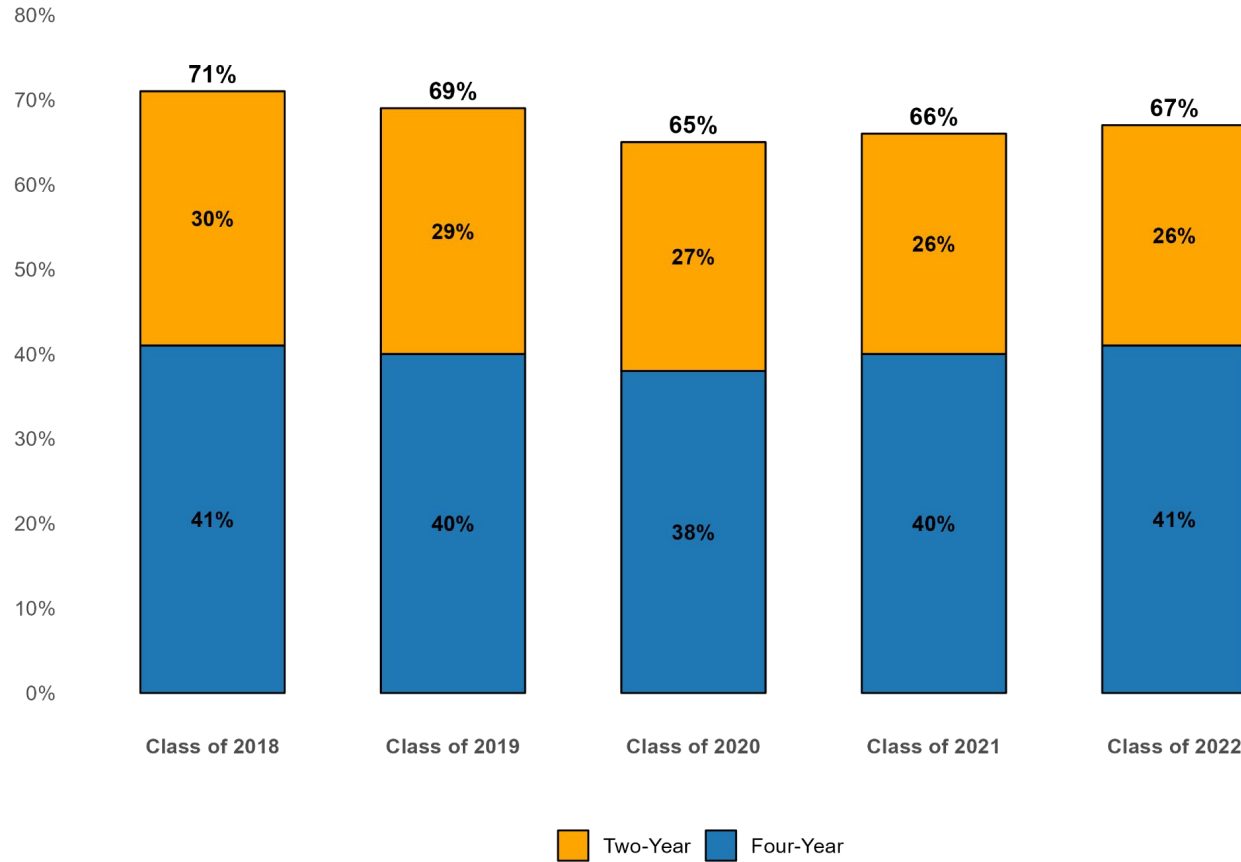

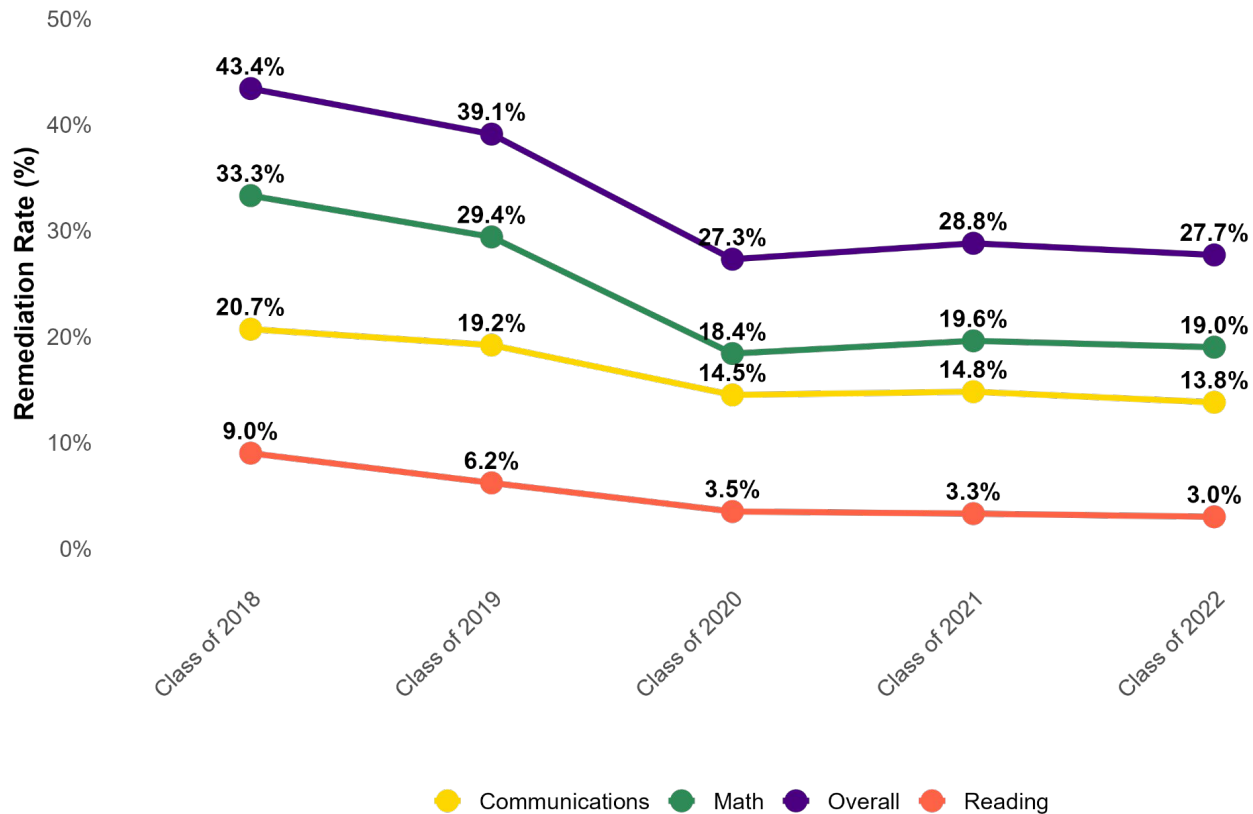

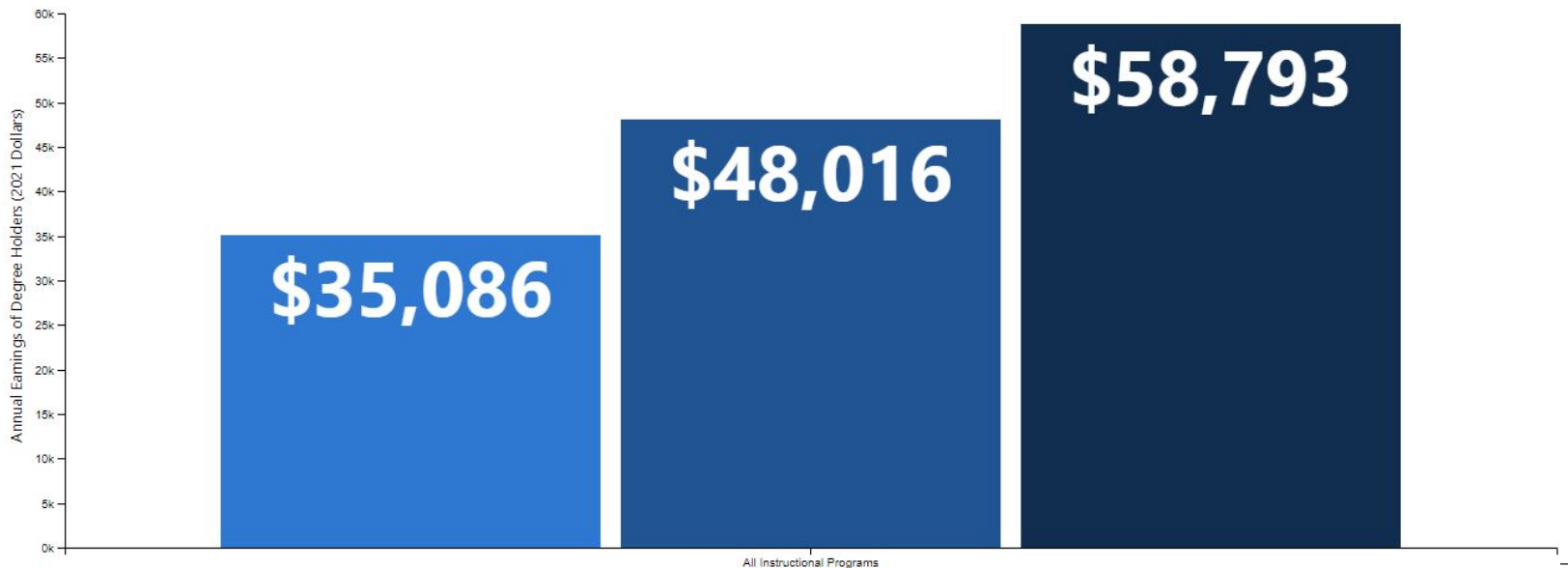

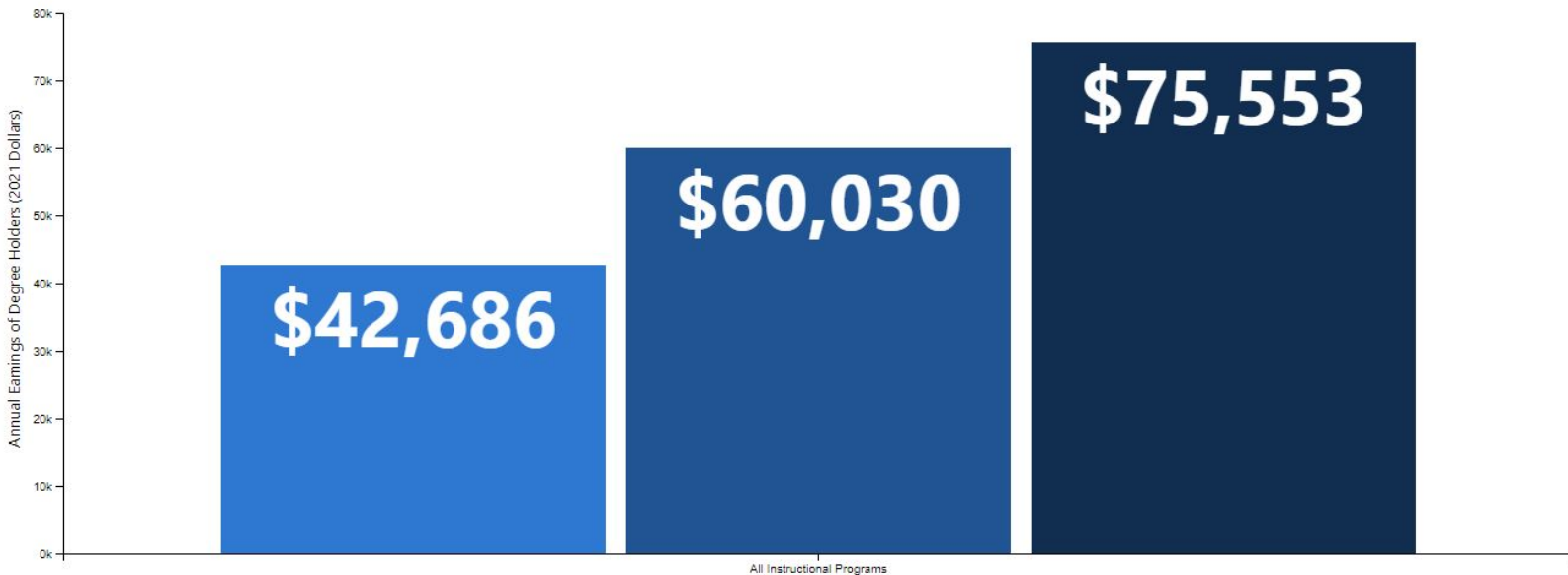

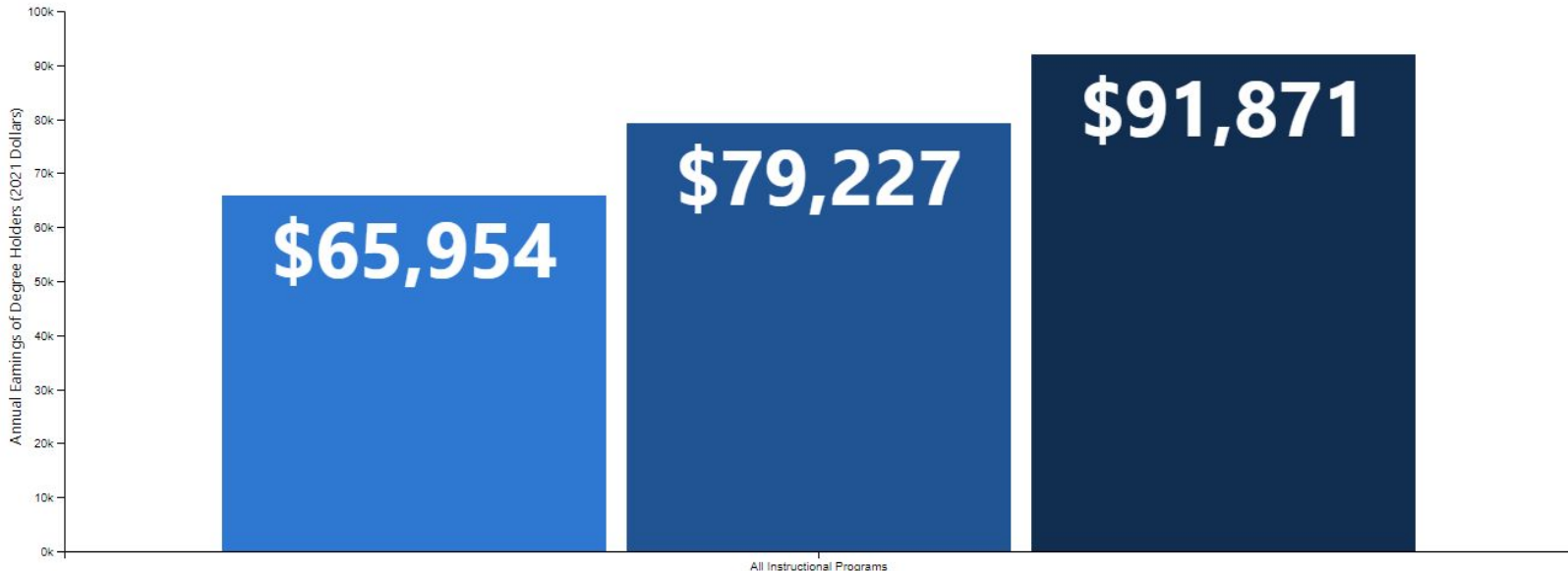
