COMPACT History

- Formed in 1989 as a non-profit corporation
- Affiliated with U of I Extension in the 1990's
- Focus: to strengthen the transition of young people from school to the world of work
- Supported programs aimed at improving academic preparation and career readiness





COMPACT Evolution

- In 2013, the COMPACT established new vision and mission statements aimed at forming alliances and facilitating community efforts to improve college and career readiness.
- Focus changed from developing programs to enhancing partnerships.
- Today, the McLean County Community COMPACT creatively enlists the support of community stakeholders from business, government, labor, education and the community to further its purpose.
